DR. KAMPRATH BY THE NUMBERS...

Eugene Kamprath grew up in the farming community of Seward, Nebraska. He graduated from the University of Nebraska in 1950 with a BS degree in Agronomy and an MS degree in 1952. Upon earning his

PhD (Agronomy) in 1955 from North Carolina State University, he joined the Department of Soil Science as an Assistant Professor. His entire professional career has been at NC State, being promoted to Associate Professor in 1958 and Professor in 1963. During this same period of career advancement, he was Director of the Soil Testing Division in the North Carolina Department of Agriculture. Dr. Kamprath is a Fellow of the American Society of Agronomy and the Soil Science Society of America and was named a William Neal Reynolds Distinguished Professor in 1981. He served as Department Head for seven years beginning in 1989, and officially retired in 1996. Under his tutelage, 17 MS and 26 PhD students have received their degrees. Dr. Kamprath's service to professional societies has been extensive at state, regional, national, and international levels. Even now, Gene continues to team-teach the undergraduate and graduate soil fertility courses, serves on departmental committees and advises graduate students.

AND NOW, HIS LEGACY....

Gene has enjoyed a remarkable professional career that spans 50-plus years. His rich

history of achievements as a scientist, teacher, mentor, and administrator has had a profound influence on generations of soil scientists and students, many of whom continue this legacy throughout the world in their own careers in soil science. The advancement of knowledge from his research in soil acidity and liming, soil and management factors influencing P, K, and S availability, and crop N-use efficiency relationships has been instrumental in enhancing productivity and fostering sound environmental management that has benefited humankind as near as NC and as far away as Latin America, Africa, and Asia. His scientific accomplishments, the national and international recognition they have earned, and his position of influence among peers have not altered his basic qualities of modesty, warmth, and concern for others. His life and work reflect the highest standards of a scientist and a person.

To honor his contributions to his field, the *Eugene J. Kamprath Soil Science Scholarship Endowment* has been established.

This endowment will benefit the department in perpetuity through fellowship support to graduate students and scholarship awards for undergraduates.
