Discipline The Camp Staff, including Summer Camp Staff, Extension 4-H Agents, and Volunteer 4-H Leaders, have permission to appropriately discipline my child. Discipline may be used when a camp participant is violating Camp or 4-H rules, is violating state or federal law, is disobeying reasonable instructions/demands from Camp Staff, is creating a safety risk, is disrupting Camp programs or activities, or is otherwise creating a risk of harm to the Camp, its programs or its integrity, or other people or their property. Discipline may range from loss of privileges to "time-out" to dismissal from the Camp. The camp staff have the right to physically restrain my child when, in their opinion, the child is a danger to themselves or others. I understand that the County Extension 4-H Agent and/or the Camp Director reserve the right to dismiss my child if they become a discipline problem or disruptive to the program, in which the parent/guardian must immediately pick up the child upon notice of the dismissal. Staff will counsel campers whenever possible to avoid dismissal.

Medical Cost and Insurance Neither the 4-H Camp nor the Camp Staff shall be liable for the cost of any medical treatment. Camp insurance covers only certain accidents and illnesses. I/we will be responsible for, and pay for, any medical charges not covered by insurance. Limit of camp insurance for accidents is \$3,500 for injury and \$1,000 for illness. Camper illness and/or injury sustained while at camp must be reported and recorded while on site to be covered by the camp's insurance. Pre-existing illness (asthma, diabetes, etc.) is not covered.

Campers' Personal Property Neither the 4-H Camp nor the Staff shall be responsible for the loss of, or damage to personal property of the camper. Campers should not bring radios, video games, cell phones, or other expensive items to camp. The Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Property Damage I/We will be responsible for, and pay, for damage done by my child.

Leaving Camp Property NO ONE is to leave the Camp property without the permission of the Camp Director and/or the 4-H Agent. Permission must be secured before leaving Camp property.

Special Needs If your child has special needs, and you desire any assistive devices, services, or other accommodations to participate in this program, please contact the Camp and/or the County 4-H Agent regarding the child's needs at least 30 days prior to camp. Campers need to be able to dress, eat, and use the restroom without assistance and participate in traditional camp activities.

Voice and Likeness Release: please check box if NOT giving consent

I understand that the 4-H Camp is a division of the Department of 4-H Youth Development, College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, North Carolina State University (hereinafter referred to as University). By this release, I consent to the use of my child's likeness and voice, including all photographs, video, internet use, and sound recording for educational or promotional purposes by the University, or anyone authorized by the University. I acknowledge that the University is the sole owner of all rights to such material on my participation. I understand that I shall receive no compensation for my/ or my child's appearance and participation in this project. If the participant is a minor child, I represent that I am the parent/guardian and I hereby consent to the foregoing on his/her behalf.

Custody Release: You may be asked to produce photo ID at check-out. This is for your child's safety. Please be aware of this policy before picking up your child.
