### FOOTNOTES:

1. Junior & senior riders compete in the same class.
2. Horses & ponies compete in the same class.
3. Must be plain shod with natural tail.
4. Determined by points.
5. Class held in outdoor arena.
6. Exhibitors 12 years of age or younger.
7. Entries to walk and jog.
8. Class to run concurrently with Dressage Classes. Starting time dependent upon number of dressage entries.
9. Exhibitors 12 years of age or older.
10. Must qualify at District show by placing 1st or 2nd in respective Equitation Over Fence Class for the Hunter Division, or Stock Seat Equitation Class for the Western Division.
11. Open only to non-trotting breeds.
12. Canter not allowed.
13. Walking, Racking, and Spotted Saddle Horses are ineligible for this class
14. Must have completed a course of eight fences at respective district show to be eligible.
15. Only open to Saddleseat Trotting breeds
