Registration Fees

Early - Registration must be received by 5pm 3 days in advance of each workshop date (the Tuesday before each Friday workshop).

- \$125 per person receiving continuing education credit; workshop notebook is included.
- \$30 per person *not* receiving continuing education credit; workshop notebook is not included.

Regular - Register within 3 days of the workshop date.

- \$150 per person receiving continuing education credit; workshop notebook is included.
- \$40 per person *not* receiving continuing education credit; workshop notebook is not included.

The notebook is available for \$20. All registrants must attend a workshop to receive their notebook, or a notebook can be mailed for an additional \$5 for Shipping and Handling.
